Alternatives for linking students and alumni with organizations.

What is CTP?

The Center for Professional Development (CTP) provides support to students and alumni in the construction of their academic and professional objectives.

CTP works non-stop to create links with businesses and organizations that can complement the training and experience both of students as well as alumni.

CTP is the only unit that can act as an employment exchange for the Universidad de los Andes and that is duly authorized by the Ministry of Labor-SPE



Alternatives offered by CTP

Work while studying

Organizations can hire undergraduate or postgraduate students interested in finding paid labor that offer part-time or flex-time schedules which allow them to work without having to stop studying.

This type of activity does not generate academic credit and what is hoped is that the duties carried out by students are in some way in line with the formation objectives of their majors.

Job openings

The organizations can offer job openings to alumni and students with distinct profiles: students in the final year of undergraduate studies, graduate students, recently graduated students and those with more extensive professional careers.

CTP supports these talent searches through its work team and technological platform. (employment exchange)

Register yourself

Go to the platform.

Enter ctp.uniandes.edu.co and click on

> Ingresar a la plataforma

and later click on add a company





Enter the information requested and upon finishing click on continue.

Create contact

Enter the information of the contact and when you finish click on continue.

Add another contact

Click on add another contact and enter the information requested. Later, click on the add button.



Finish

Click on **Save Information**. The company will then be created and the system will notify CTP indicating that there is a new company pending approval. After the revision, CTP will activate the company and send notification to the main user of the company.

Creating job opportunities

On the main menu, click on **See job openings**

2

Click on the option create job opening.

3

click on one of these options: job opening, internship or work-study 4

The system displays the job opening form in which the information can be entered.

When you finish click on **Save**.
The system creates the job opening and subsequently sends notification to CTP for its revision and activation.

All of the contacts of the company can enter the tool and create job openings which will be registered as "creating job opening" and once it has been reviewed and approved by CTP, the opening will be changed to "active job opening"

For security reasons, the system has a time limit for publishing the job opportunity, if this takes more than twenty (20) minutes, it is possible that you will lose the input information once you click on "publish".

If a job opening has been on the platform for longer than two weeks after the expiration date, the company must download the resumes of the applicants and then must close the opening. If this is not done, the tool will block the company from posting new job openings until it has closed the previous ones.

These are done throughout the year in accordance with the availability of the company.
